The Assessment for students of Std. IX will be followed as per the CBSE guidelines.

1. Assessment of Scholastic/subjects will be reported for each semester.

The nine point grading scale is as follows:

B1	71 – 80	8.0
B2	61 – 70	7.0

2. There will be four Formative Assessments with a weightage of 10% each and two Summative Assessments (SA1 and SA2) with a weightage of 30% each.

First Term : FA1 (10%) + FA2 (10%) + SA1 (30%) = 50%

Second Term : FA3 (10%) + FA4 (10%) + SA2 (30%) = 50%

3. Co – Scholastic Assessment will be reported once a year at the end of Semester II on a 5 point scale as shown in the table given below.

Note:

- The minimum qualifying grade in Scholastic and Co-Scholastic Domain is D
- All assessment with regard to the academic status of the students shall be done in marks and the assessment will be given in grades.
- CGPA (Cumulative grade Point Average) will be provided, excluding additional 6th Subject, as per Scheme of studies.

4. For the Summative Assessments:

- Maximum marks for each subject will be 90.
- The time duration of each paper will be 3hrs.

5. The Summative Assessment Answer Books of the students will be preserved and kept in safe custody at the school for a period of three years for any subsequent verification by the Board. Therefore, the students will be shown the answer books in school, but will not be allowed to take them home.

6. 75% attendance is mandatory for promotion to the next class, as per CBSE guidelines. As CCE is an ongoing assessment process, students are required to be in school to benefit from the system. You are requested to ensure that your wards do not fall short of attendance.
