Our School is starting the **PEC** Programme conceived by the **UK government, in collaboration with the British Council, UK sport, UNICEF and Govt. of India (MHRD and MYAS)**. It's a sport development programme to raise awareness and understanding of the impact of physical education. The practice of physical education and sport is a fundamental Human Right for all.
