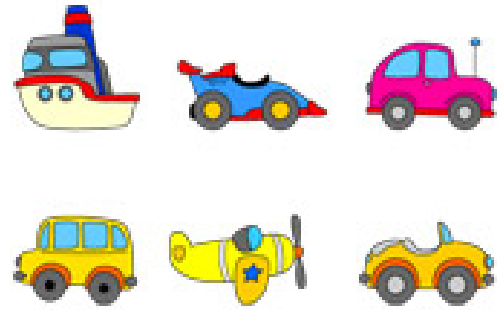

CREATIVE DEVELOPMENT

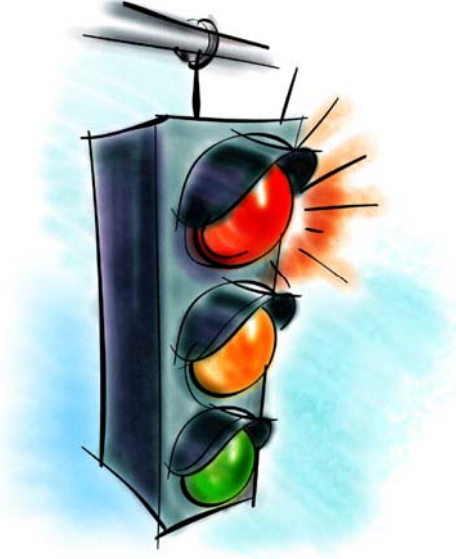

Yellow light, yellow light

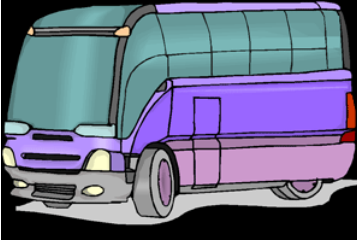
What do you say?
